**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR #89-02**

Building Owners/Administrators Concerned

This is in reference to the launching of the MACEA/MAPA on-street pay parking project. Notices of effectivity and maps of area(s) concerned were circularized earlier.


In this regard it has been verified that unauthorized signs and barricades reserving portions of the streets for building occupants have been installed. Please be informed in this connection that only signs authorized to be installed on sidewalks and other areas are those specified by Municipal Ordinances #10, #38, and #45. All other signs are therefore disauthorized and subject for removal.

In consideration of the foregoing, please take immediate steps to remove unauthorized signs, if you have installed any, on the sidewalks or street areas. Henceforth, any such signs and/or barricades verified interfering with parking patterns and procedures instituted by the MAKATI PARKING AUTHORITY (MAPA) in conjunction with MACEA will be removed and impounded.
