
MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 96-14

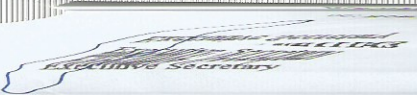
