FOR: ALL MEMBERS/BUILDING ADMINISTRATORS
SUBJECT : MODIFIED ENHANCE COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MECQ)

Pursuant to the pronouncement of Resolution No. 109-A by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases, the provinces of Bulacan, Cavite, Laguna, Rizal, the urbanized cities of National Capital Region, and the municipality of Pateros shall be placed under Modified Enhance Community Quarantine from April 12 to 30, 2021.

The following guidelines shall be implemented within MACEA:

1. Curfew hours from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. will be implemented, without prejudice to the issuances imposed by the LGU and subject to the guidelines issued by DILG. Workers in permitted industries and establishments, cargo vehicles, and public transportation shall be exempted from the curfew.
2. During non-curfew hours, movement of all individuals is limited to accessing essential goods and services. Person aged below 18 and above 65, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, and other health risks, and pregnant women must remain in their residences at all times, except when obtaining essential goods and services.
3. Essential and priority construction projects, whether public or private, shall be allowed to continue their operation in accordance with guidelines issued by the Department of Public Works and Highways under D.O. No 30, series of 2021. Small scale projects, for private and personal use shall not be allowed.
4. Public transportation shall be allowed to operate at capacity and protocols provided by the Department of Transportation. Number coding in Makati is lifted during MECQ period.
5. Religious gatherings are allowed up to 10% of the venue capacity.
6. Walks, Jogging, Running or Biking, are allowed within the general area of their residence, provided, that social distancing protocols and minimum public health standards are observed.
7. Only essential stores like groceries, pharmacies and hardware are allowed to remain open in Malls. Restaurants may remain open for take-out and delivery services only and outdoor dining is allowed at 50% capacity.

MACEA enjoins everyone to be cautious and compliant to the policies issued and enforced by IATF. We shall keep you posted should there be any latest announcements from the government for proper guidance of all concerned.
