TO : ALL MEMBERS/BUILDING ADMINISTRATORS
SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MECQ)

Pursuant to the pronouncement by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte last April 28, 2021, the provinces of Bulacan, Laguna, Rizal, the urbanized cities of National Capital Region, and the municipality of Pateros shall remain under Modified Enhance Community Quarantine from May 01 to 15, 2021.

The following guidelines shall be implemented within MACEA:

1. In line with the MMDA Resolution No. 21-09 Series of 2021, standardized and unified curfew hours from 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. will be implemented, without prejudice to the issuances imposed by the LGU and subject to the guidelines issued by DILG. Workers in permitted industries and establishments, cargo vehicles, and public transportation shall be exempted from the curfew.
2. During non-curfew hours, movement of all individuals is limited to accessing essential goods and services. Person aged below 18 and above 65, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidity, and other health risks, and pregnant women must remain in their residences at all times, except when obtaining essential goods and services.
3. Essential and priority construction projects, whether public or private, shall be allowed to continue their operation in accordance with guidelines issued by the Department of Public Works and Highways under D.O. No. 30, series of 2021
4. Small-scale projects, such as those for housing and residential, may be allowed under D. O. No. 33 series of 2021 as long as they are in strict compliance with the Revised Construction Safety Guidelines outlined in D. O. No. 30 series of 2021.
5. Public transportation shall be allowed to operate at capacity and protocols provided by the Department of Transportation. Number coding in Makati is lifted during MECQ period.
6. Religious gatherings are allowed up to 10% of the venue capacity
7. Walks, Jogging, Running or Biking, are allowed within the general area of their residences, provided that the social distancing protocols and minimum public health standards are observed.
8. Dine-in services in restaurant is allowed at 10% seating capacity.
9. Barbershops and Beauty Parlors are allowed to operate on 30% capacity on services that can accommodate wearing of face mask.

MACEA enjoins everyone to be cautious and compliant to the policies issued by IATF. We shall keep you posted should there be any latest announcements from the government for proper guidance of all concerned.
