TO : ALL MEMBERS/PROPERTY MANAGERS
RE : MAKATI CITY SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION

Makati City has issued Executive Order No. 12 on Guidelines for the Implementation of the Safety Seal Certification Program in accordance with the IATF Resolution No. 87. Malls, Restaurants, Coffee Shops, Sport Centers, Spas, Cinemas, Gyms, Testing Centers, Laundry Service, other retails stores, and other private establishments not covered by other issuing agencies can apply for a safety seal from the city government.

Owner or representative of the business establishment can apply for a Safety Seal Certification at <https://safetyseal.umakemakatisafe.com/> with below requirements:

1. Compliance with Registration or Accreditation (e.g., Mayor's Permit, DTI/SEC Registration or DOT Registration);
2. Usage of StaySafe.ph or any contact tracing tool;
3. Enforcement of the Minimum Public Health Standards (MPHS).

The submitted application will be reviewed by Makati City Safety Seal Team and endorsed for an actual inspection when complete in requirements. Once the government permits and eligibility requirements are verified compliant on-site, Safety Seal Certification will then be issued to the establishment. This certification shall be valid for six (6) months from the date of issuance.
