SUBJECT : DEVELOPMENT CONTROL ADVISORY – HOLY WEEK 2024

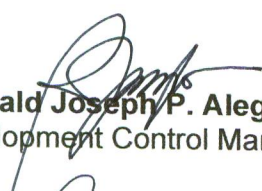
In relation to the observance of Holy Week from March 28-31, 2024, your Development Control Department would like to request all constructing members to comply with the following minimum safety and security protocols:

1. No construction works are allowed during the Holy Week. This includes all deliveries and hauling activities, to and from the construction sites.
2. Always ensure fire life and safety protocols are in place. OSH Personnel should always be deployed during the duration of the holy week.
3. All construction equipment must be properly parked and stowed away from the common areas. This includes tower cranes, gondolas, placing booms, pumpcretes, pumpcrete's pipes, and alike.
4. All construction materials should not be stored along common areas. Deliveries should be done before the Holy Week.
5. Secure all open manholes or excavations with proper covering.
6. Check all electrical installation within the construction site. It must be turned-off to avoid any electrical hazards and accidents.
7. Provide night-time lighting for the fence, overhead street protection, canopies and sidewalks.
8. Provide limited access to the site. Deploy security personnel during the duration of the holy week.
9. Faithfully comply with all the requirements set forth by the Development Control and Estate Management.

Please be guided accordingly. We will require you to submit the list of security personnel and OSH personnel that you will deploy on your respective sites with their contact information.
