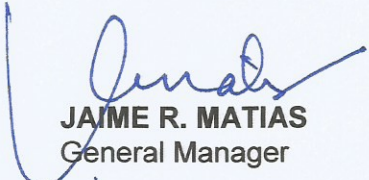
RE : OBSTRUCTIONS ALONG SIDEWALKS AND ROADWAYS

Anent to MaCEA Memo Circular 98-01 dated January 13, 1998, we have noted that obstructions on sidewalks remained prevalent particularly of parked vehicles, portable signages, barricades and the like. In addition, the use/installation of steel and concrete ramps on the curbs/gutters for vehicular ingress and egress have also been observed in many areas.

We, therefore, remind everyone to desist from putting such obstructions as well as to refrain from parking vehicles on any part of the sidewalk so as not to create hazards and obstructions to pedestrians.

For the information of everyone, the width of the sidewalk along major roads, except Ayala Avenue, Makati Avenue. and Paseo de Roxas (Ayala Ave. to Gil Puyat Ave.), is 3.00M while backstreets or secondary streets have a width of 1.50M.

Vehicles encroaching the sidewalk area will be towed while steel/concrete ramps installed on the curbs and gutters, portable signs and barricades placed on the roadway and/or sidewalk areas will be cleared by MaCEA and the cost of such work will be charged to the account of the concerned building.
