The Makati City government has established the Makati Command Center (C3) at the 24th floor of the Makati City Hall. The Command Center, described as a "mini – 911", is capable of receiving and responding to emergency calls anywhere in Makati area on a 24-hour basis. It has facilities for locating the presence of police, DPS, rescue vehicles and personnel through a Global Positioning System (GPS) and immediately deploying them to critical areas.

To get a better grasp of what the Command Center is all about, we are inviting you and your security officer for a guided tour of the facilities on Thursday, March 15, 2007. Councilor Jejomar Erwin S. Binay, Jr., Chairman of the Peace and Order Committee of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, will give a briefing on the operational aspect of the Command Center. Please be at the Executive Lounge, 22/F of the Makati City Hall by 2:00 p.m. on said date.
