TO : ALL BUILDING ADMINISTRATORS
SUBJECT: DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS WASTES

We would like to remind all building administrators that disposal of hazardous wastes such as used UPS (used batteries), mercury bulbs, toners, electronic wastes etc. is strictly prohibited.

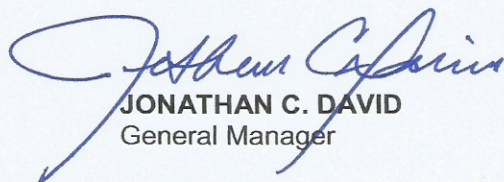
This is in line with the Republic Act 6969, otherwise known as "Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Control Act of 1990", and DENR administrative order no. 29 series of 1992 which defines "all establishments, companies, offices and the like who produce, use, transport and dispose hazardous substances and wastes shall be responsible for the storage and disposal of any generated waste from its operations through an appointed registered hazardous waste hauler which shall haul, transport and dispose the hazardous waste in accordance with the conditions of the Law".

Please see below samples of hazardous wastes:

Class	Description	Waste Number
Waste electrical and electronic equipment	Ink, cartridges, toners, etc.	M506
Special Wastes	Household HWs such as paints, thinners, household batteries, lead-acid batteries, spray canisters and the like batteries, oil and busted lights	M507
Containers previously containing toxic chemicals	Used to hold wastes and toxic chemical substances	J201
Waste oil	Used Industrial Oil including sludges	I101
Lead Compounds	> 1mg/L concentration	D406
Mercury and its compounds	> 1mg/L concentration Busted Fluorescent Bulbs	D407
