MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 2020-16

SUBJECT : MAKATI CITY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20: GUIDELINES ON MECQ

Pursuant to the pronouncement of President Rodrigo Duterte on August 2, 2020, National Capital Region will be placed again under the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) from August 4 to 18, 2020.

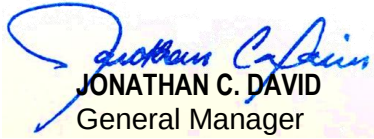
Makati City issued last August 6, 2020 Executive Order No. 20 or the Guidelines for the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine. The following shall be implemented within Makati City:

1. **Going Out:** Movement of all persons shall be strictly limited to accessing basic necessities and services. Under City Ordinance No. 2020-089, everyone is mandated to wear face masks and other similar protective equipment.
2. **Curfew:** The curfew ordinance from 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM will be strictly implemented.
3. **Transportation:** Public transport is suspended while the number coding scheme is temporarily suspended during the MECQ. Effective August 15, 2020 all passengers using any mode of public transportation will be required to wear face shields aside from face masks, as mandated by the Department of Transportation (DOTr).
4. **Activities:** Minimum health standards and precautions such as wearing of masks and maintaining a distance of one to two meters from one another should be observed at all times. Mass gatherings and face-to-face or in-person classes at all levels are prohibited. Allowed activities are: Individual outdoor exercises (walking, jogging, running and biking); critical government services and authorized humanitarian activities; religious activities, with only a maximum of 5 persons in the gathering; wakes, internment and burials of individuals who passed away but not due to COVID19.
5. **Closed facilities:** During MECQ, city-run facilities, tourist destinations, entertainment industries (cinemas and bars), kids amusement industries, libraries, museums, gyms, fitness studios and sports facilities and personal care services will be closed.

6. **Limited operations:** All establishments that allowed to remain open shall strictly enforce social distancing measures, such as but not limited to skeleton staffing, temperature checking, use of masks and gloves and other requirements that may be implemented by the Makati City Government.
7. **No Dine-In Policy:** All food establishments must be allowed for delivery and take-out orders only. Restaurants outside malls are exempted from the curfew and allowed to operate until 10 pm. Owners of these businesses are advised to find suitable housing for their employees residing outside Makati as other cities may not have the same curfew.

MACEA, Inc. enjoins everyone to be cautious and compliant to the policies by IATF and the ordinances and executive orders being implemented. We shall keep you posted should there be any latest announcements from the government for proper guidance of all concerned.
