RE : IMPORTANT ADVISORY ON GARBAGE

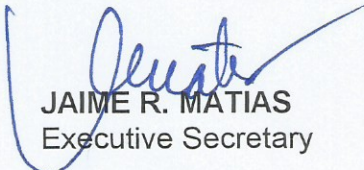
Please be advised that the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) shall be conducting a "dry run" on waste segregation from May 27, 1999 to June 24, 1999, in preparation for the full implementation of MMDA Resolution No. 99-004 entitled "Regulation Governing Proper Refuse Management at Source in Metro Manila Area and for Other Purposes."

MMDA Regulation No. 99-004 requires every one to segregate their garbage using the following color coded system:

|-------------------|--|
| GREEN BAG | - Biodegradable wastes such as kitchen food scraps. |
| BLACK BAG | - Non-biodegradable wastes such as tin and aluminum cans, plastic and glass bottles, plastic and paper wrappers, carton boxes. |
| RED BAG | - Hazardous wastes such as batteries, insecticides, small chemical containers. |
| YELLOW BAG | - Pathological wastes. |

MMDA will only accept segregated wastes at the San Mateo Sanitary Landfill starting Thursday, May 27, 1999. We are, therefore, requesting for your cooperation so that garbage collection will not be hampered.
